our mission, and had got through to the beach. General Eichelberger said "Maybe you just saw a lagoon, Sergeant Bottcher." "No, General", I said, "I saw the ocean." "I'll come up and look the position over", said the General. And he came up, right through the wedge, and looked it over.

FOLSTER:

And that's just a sample of the confined fighting, through jungle swamps — tree by tree — pillbox by pillbox — that has won us nearly all of Papua back from the Japs. Thank you Captain Bottcher, Captain Bailey and Lieutenant Schwartz.
