

POWER OF ATTORNEY

KNOW ALL MEN, that--

WHEREAS, HERMANN J. BOTTCHER, deceased, who during his lifetime was a resident of the City and County of San Francisco, State of California, United States of America and who was killed in action while serving overseas with the United States Army as a Captain, AUS, ASN O-888451, did execute a Last Will and Testament wherein the undersigned, ALICE BRUNCKMANN, formerly ALICE BOTTCHER, presently residing at 239 Russell Street, San Francisco, California, was named as residuary legatee and executrix to serve without bond; and

WHEREAS, the third paragraph of said Will reads as follows:

"THIRD: I give, devise and bequeath to Anne H. Seney, 1st Lt, A.N.C. Serial Number H-741831, of Newport News, Virginia, now stationed at Base 7, A.P.O. #927, c/o Postmaster, San Francisco, California, a herd of cattle stationed with Arthur Walton, Howes Valley, New South Wales, Australia, and all moneys on deposit with Commonwealth Savings Bank of Australia, Singleton, N.S.W. Branch. I further give, devise and bequeath to said Anne H. Seney the sum of One Thousand dollars to be paid to her when and if she returns to the United States of America."

WHEREAS, the said HERMANN J. BOTTCHER left no property of any kind whatsoever in the United States of America which will require probate of said Will or administration of his said estate, and the only property belonging to the said HERMANN J. BOTTCHER at the time of his death, as far as is known at the date hereof, consisted of the cattle hereinabove mentioned and any money on deposit in Australia; and

WHEREAS, the undersigned ALICE BRUNGGEMANN, formerly ALICE BOTTCHER, is a resident of the State of California and not of Australia; and
WHEREAS, the undersigned, ALICE BRUNGGEMANN, formerly ALICE BOTTCHER, is desirous of having the property of said decedent disposed of in accordance with the wishes of the said HERMANN J. BOTTCHER;

NOW, THEREFORE, I the said ALICE BRUNGGEMANN do hereby appoint the said ANNE H. SENNY, whose permanent address is 311 59th Street, New Port News, Virginia, to be my true and lawful attorney in fact, with full power of substitution, for me and in my name, place and stead, to demand,

sue for, attach, levy, recover and receive any and all sums of money and property now situate in the Commonwealth of Australia that now are or hereafter shall become due, owing and payable or receivable, under or by virtue of the foregoing provision of the Last Will and Testament of the said HERMANN J. BOTTCHEK, deceased, with full power and authority to sell, assign, transfer, set over, pledge, compromise, or discharge the whole or any part thereof, and to do any and all other acts and things necessary or proper to carry out the wishes of the said HERMANN J. BOTTCHEK, deceased, with respect to said property, hereby ratifying and confirming all that the said ANNE H. SENNY, or her substitute or substitutes shall, or may lawfully do or cause to be done by virtue hereof.
