ALIGH THURSGENARY, being first duly sworn, deposes and says!

That she arrived in Sydney, Amstralia, in 1928 and that later that

year, she met GEORGE POTTCHER at the German Glub; that he was introduced

to her by a friend and that it was love at first eight; that after a

short courtship, they decided to live together as man and wife although

their marriage was not actually solomized until July of 1930.

That at the time they first began to live together as man and wife, GEORGE BOTTCHER had sent for a member, MERMANN BOTTCHER, an orphan living with GEORGE BOTTCHER'S parents in Landsborg, Germany; that MEMMANN arrived in Sydney in 1939 and lived with affiant and GEORGE BOTTCHER for several meaths before he left for the country where he worked on a farm; that while he was working on the farm, he visited with affiant and GEORGE BOTTCHER frequently and left all of his personal effects with them; that GEORGE BOTTCHER felt a strong sense of responsibility for HERMANN BOTTCHER, who was orphaned at the age of nine years; that he treated him as a son and that affiant concerned in this feeling.

That while affiant and GEORGE BOTTCHER were in Sydney, they moved several times and worked at several different places; that GEORGE BOTTCHER worked as a carpenter and affiant as a dressmaker; that they reated house-breezing rooms inseruch as they did not own a home of their own; that irrespective of where they lived, when HERMANN BOTTCHER was in the city, he lived with affiant and GEORGE BOTTCHER, and that when HERMANN BOTTCHER worked in the country, he left his personal affects with affiant and GEORGE BOTTCHER and that he visited them frequently.

That this was the relationship of affiant and GHORGE POTTCHER to HERMANN BOTTCHER before affiant and GHORGE BOTTCHER were married and for many months before HERMANN BOTTCHER reached his majority; that HERMANN BOTTCHER was regarded as a son by them and as a member of their household.

That in August of 1930 shortly after affiant and GRORGE BOTTCHER were formally married, they left for the United States and gave HERMANN BOTTCHUR the money to follow them to the United States as soon as they had established themselves and had definitely decided to remain in the United States; that within a few weeks after arrival, they notified HERMANN BOTTCHER of their intentions of staying and that he issediately case to the United States; that HURMANN DOTTONER lived with affinnt and her husband during the entire period after that time, with the expection of about two years following 1937, at which time he was fighting with the Spanish Loyalists in Spain; that after his return from Spain, he lived with affiant and her busband all through the intervening period and through the sickness of GEORGE POTTONER, followed by his passing on 17 Jamesry 1941; that after the death of GRORGE BOTTCHER, HERMANN FOTTCHER continued to live with affiant and her daughter until he enlisted in the United States Army on 5 January 1943.

That it is difficult for affiant to remember the exact dates concerning her experiences in Australia because they were so long ago and at that time the present need could not be foressen; that furthermore the ship on which affiant and her husband sailed in August of 1930 was sunk and all of their records were lost; that they were fortunate to survive; that the name of the ship was the Tahiti.
